Fostering Positive Behaviour & School Values

At Wortham, we have high expectations for standards of behaviour. Our school values of Respect, Compassion, Resilience, and Kindness are firmly embedded. Many children have already been recognised for demonstrating these values and have proudly brought home our mini value certificates.

We also use the '**Zones of Regulation**' program to help children recognise and manage their emotions effectively. This may be new to our Reception children; however, this term we are refreshing our understanding of the zones through weekly class assemblies, which focus on recognising our feelings and the tools needed to return to the green zone.

To support the use of the Zones of Regulation at home, we have included a parent information leaflet with this email. Your help in assisting your child to understand and manage their emotions would be greatly appreciated.
