Waveney Foodbank Assembly

We were pleased to welcome Matthew Scade from Waveney Foodbank into school this week to lead a whole-school assembly. He spoke to the children about what a food bank is, the important work it does in our local area, and how we can all help to support families in need.

Matthew explained that Waveney Foodbank needs around 300 kg of food each day to meet demand across South Norfolk and North Suffolk. The children listened with great interest and asked thoughtful questions about which donations are most useful and how these contributions help families locally.

Important Notice - Collecting Children from School

To help us keep all children safe, please ensure that if someone other than a parent or an authorised adult (listed on Arbor, for example a grandparent) is collecting your child, you let us know in advance by email or telephone.

This applies to end-of-day collection, as well as collection from after-school clubs or wrap-around care.

We are only able to release children to parents or adults authorised on Arbor. If someone different is collecting your child — for example, another child's parent or a relative not listed on Arbor — this must be authorised directly by a parent, again via email or telephone, before collection.

If we have not received confirmation, we will not be able to release your child to that adult.

Even if an adult is listed on Arbor, if they do not collect on a regular basis, it is always helpful to let us know of any changes in collection. This ensures staff are aware in advance and that collections run smoothly.

Thank you for working with us to keep all children safe and cared for.
