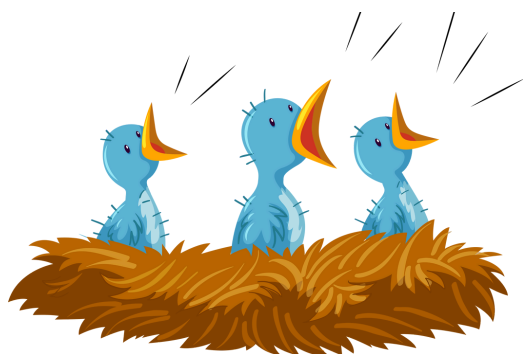
First Aid
