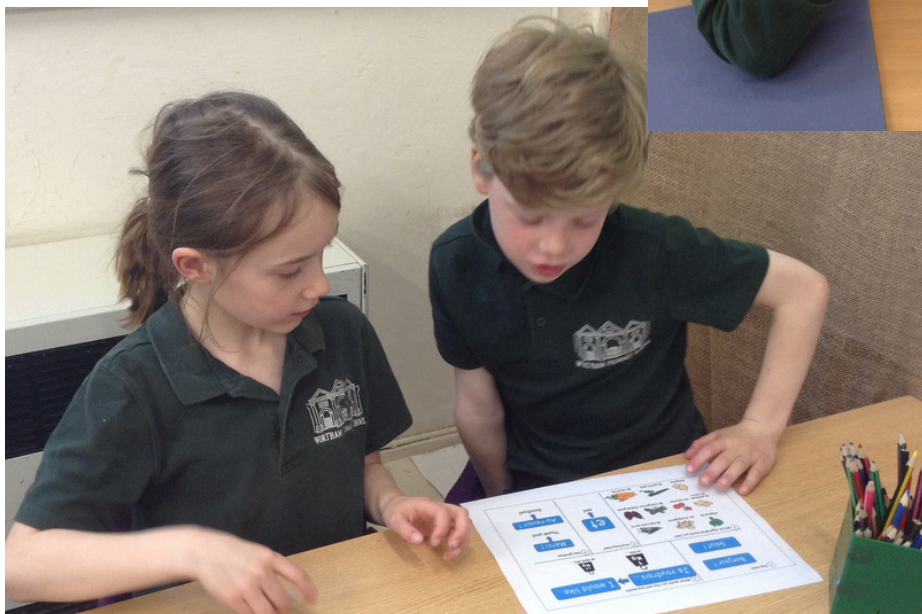
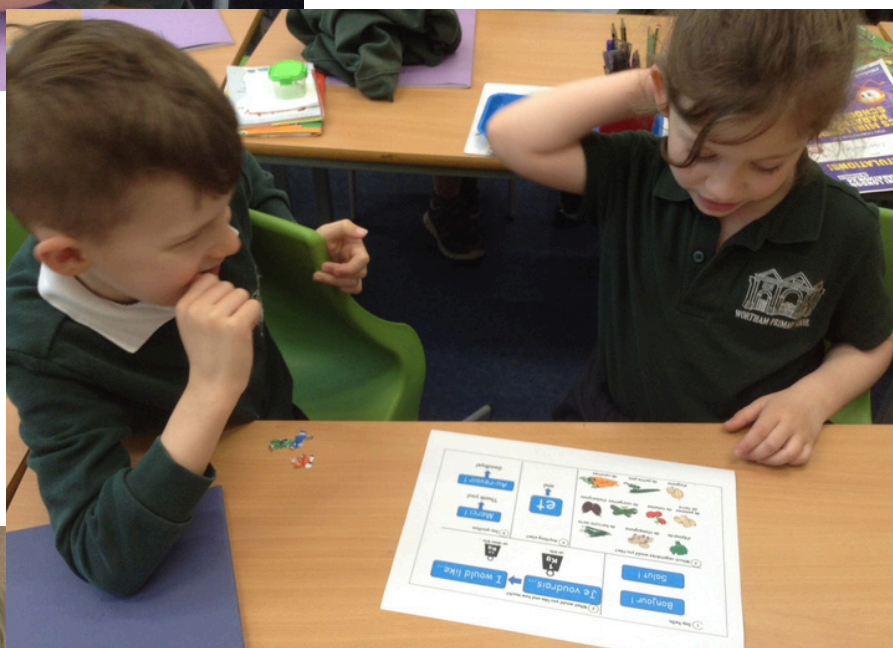
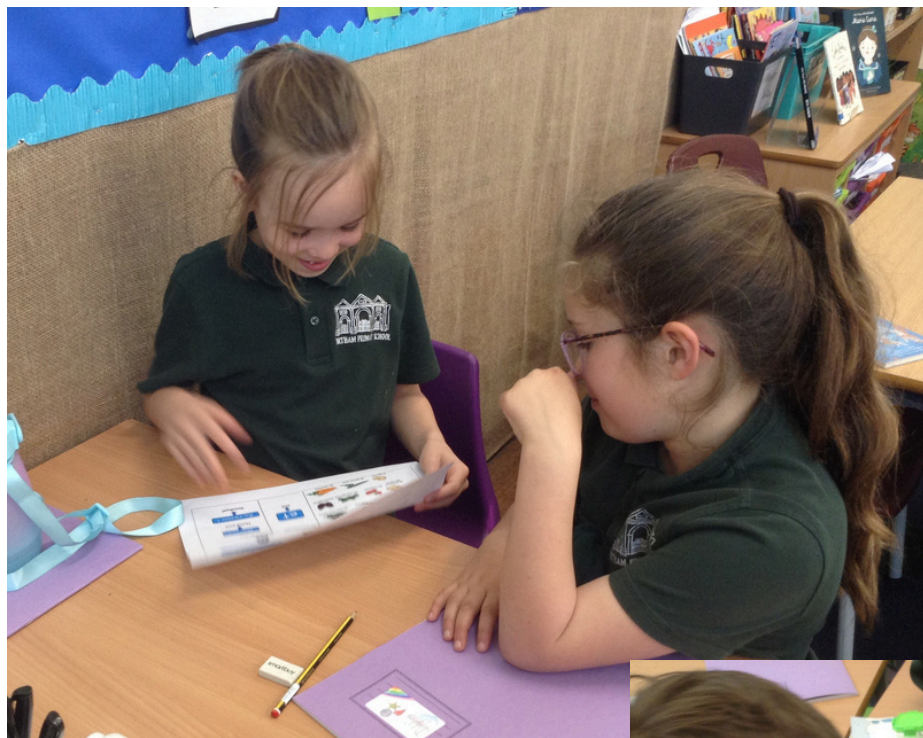
# Busy Bumblebees!

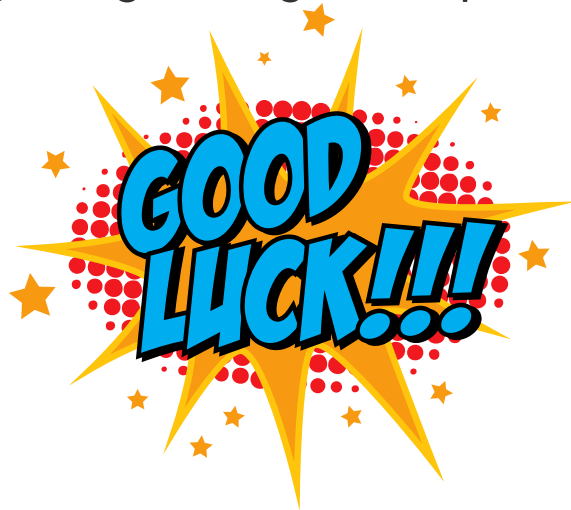
## Bikeability
