

Annual Curriculum Plan



We made a decision to focus on teaching our curriculum in a way that would provide the best learning possible for our children. Our timetable is structured so that it immerses children in a subject for a period of three weeks. There are subjects which are taught daily, these are: English, Phonics and Maths. Weekly the children are taught French, Computing, Science, PE, Music and PSHE/RE. Our other subjects which include, History, Geography, Art and Design and Design and Technology are taught for two full afternoons sessions over a course of three weeks. We have discovered that this approach supports our children in retaining key elements of each subjects' knowledge base and really immerses them in their learning of each separate discipline. The children have been extremely positive about learning in this way, and we are proud of the high-quality work that they create during these focused periods. Children have many opportunities to create work of exquisite quality which we display proudly around the school.

Subjects to be taught daily: English and Maths

Subjects to be taught Weekly: Science, Computing, French, PE, Music and RE/PSHE (*PSHE 'Changing Me' is taught as a topic in a 3 week block*)

Subjects to taught in a three-week cycle throughout the year: History, Art & Design, Geography and Design and Technology.

Blocks at the end of each term: Wortham Art Exhibition, STEM and World Studies – these units are where we further enhance our curriculum and go above and beyond the National Curriculum.
